# **Show Information**

The 2016 Milner Downs Classic's will be run according to the rules of Equine Canada. All owners, riders and trainers must be EC members. They must also be HCBC members or members of their provincial Equestrian Association. Foreign riders, owners and trainers must be members of their appropriate federation. These are EC Gold Level horse shows. Every class offered herein is covered by the rules and specifications of the current rules of EC and will be held and judged in accordance with the EC Rule Book.

**MANAGEMENT:** The Competition Management reserves the right to interpret all questions and conditions in regards to or arising out of or incident to the Milner Downs Classic Competitions without claims for damages or recourse of any kind. All questions not covered by these rules and regulations shall be decided by the Competition Management and their decision is final. The Competition Management reserves the right to refuse, accept conditionally, or cancel any entries, disqualify riders, exhibitors, prohibit claim damages; to change any course, to cancel or combine any unfilled competitions, after due notice to exhibitors; to change rings or rotate judges, and to change specifications in jumper competitions.

**ENTRY PROCEDURE:** All entries must be made in writing and signed by the owner or agent. Entries of junior riders must be signed by the parent or legal guardian. Entry fees must accompany entry form. Any horse listed "Entry" is not acceptable. One number will be assigned to each horse. Correct numbers must be worn and clearly visible at all times when riding on the grounds. No number will be issued unless all fees have been paid. A service fee of \$35.00 will be charged on all NSF cheques.

Entries received after the show has started will pay a late fee of \$50.

American exhibitors wishing to pay by cheque drawn in US funds will be charged the going rate on the date of the cheque. U.S. exhibitors wishing to pay in Canadian Funds must pay by bank draft or credit card.

**LATE ENTRIES**: Entries received after Classic I and II closing date will be subject to a late entry fee of \$50.00. There will be no exceptions. Late entries should confirm the availability of stabling before travelling to the show.

**CHANGES**: Every entry will pay a \$25.00 add/scratch/change fee. There will be no additional fee for adds made in the office in writing **by 5:00pm** the day before the class. Classes added the day of will be charged the cost of the class plus a \$10.00 fee per class. No adds are allowed once the class has started. In order for a full class fee refund the class must be scratched in the office before the class starts. Classes scratched at the gate only will not be refunded.

#### **REFUNDS**

- <u>Cancellation Before Closing Date</u> Before closing date of entries a full refund will be given.
- <u>Cancellation after Closing Date but before the Start of the Horse show</u> Stall Fees will not be refunded. Upon presentation of a Vets Slip to the entry secretary, the entry fees, exhibitor fees, and warm-up fees will be refunded, minus an office fee of \$25 or 15% whichever is greater.
- <u>Cancellation After The Start of the Horse Show</u> Upon presentation of a Vets Slip to the entry secretary, class fees for the classes that have not been shown in, will be refunded minus a \$25 or 15% fee whichever is greater. Stall fee, nomination and exhibitor fees will not be refunded.

**EQUINE CANADA ENTRY AGREEMENT:** By entering the 2016 Milner Downs Summer Classic Horse Shows and signing the entry blank as owner, Lessee, Trainer, Manager, Agent, Coach, Driver, Rider, Handler, and on behalf of myself and my principals, representatives, employees and agents, I agree that I am subject to the Bylaws and Rules of the EC and the local rules of the competition. I agree to be bound by the Bylaws and Rules of the EC. I will accept as final the decision of the Hearing Committee on any question arising and the Rules, and agree to release and hold harmless the competition, the EC, their officials, directors and employees for any action taken under the Rules I represent that I am eligible to enter and/or participate under the rules, and every horse I am entering is eligible as entered.

\*\*Any Horse entered in any class at a competition may be selected for equine medication control testing while at the even location.

**SUBSTITUTIONS:** With a Veterinarian's certificate a new horse may be substituted for a scratched horse. There will be a \$25 substitution fee and all monies will be transferred to the new horse.

**BARN BILLS / TRAINER SPLITS –** Trainers requiring barn bills should set them up at the beginning of the horse show with a credit card or open cheque. Trainer splits must be done by no later than Saturday.

**PRIZES:** All classes - Prize for winner, ribbons to  $8^{th}$  place. Prize money will be divided as follows:  $1^{st}$  - 30%,  $2^{ND}$  - 23%,  $3^{RD}$  - 15%,  $4^{TH}$  - 12%,  $5^{th}$  - 10%,  $6^{th}$  - 10%. Unless otherwise noted. Prizes for the Champion & Reserve Champion in each division.

**STABLING:** Stall locations will be posted the Monday of each show week. Absolutely NO STALL CHANGES allowed without the approval of the show office and show manager. Stabling at \$170 per stall for the duration of the show, is available and will be assigned on a first-come basis. There is limited stabling available for horses. Some tack stalls may be available. There is a mandatory \$80 per horse charge for <u>unlimited use of shavings</u>.

PASSPORTS: Passports and current EQUINE CANADA membership and Provincial membership required.

**ENTERED & DID NOT COMPETE:** Any exhibitor who does not compete in a class in which the exhibitor is officially entered, and does not scratch according to the scratch procedures outlined above will be billed for the classes. You MUST do your paperwork in the Show Office in order to avoid this penalty.

**PROTECTIVE HEADGEAR:** At all EC sanctioned competitions, anyone mounted on a horse on the competition grounds, including foreign competitors, must wear approved helmets with safety harness correctly fastened, at all times. Juniors showing any horse in a jog for soundness must wear approved protective headwear with the attached safety harness fastened.

**HAUL-IN FEE:** There will be a \$25 a day charge per horse for haul-in.

**NON SHOWING FEE:** There will be a non showing fee \$50 for horses not entered in any classes at the competition. The non showing fee allows use of the warm-up rings and other grounds as well as access to the rings on warm-up day. All non showing horses are required to sign an entry waiver and wear a number.

**WARMUPS:** Schooling rounds may be available over a posted course in the hunter ring at a cost of \$10.00 per round. The Ashley Reber Field will not be available for schooling. Heights will be at specific times, please refer to the schedule.

SHOEING: Both main hunter and jumper rings are grass. Hunter 2 is on sand.

**DOGS:** All dogs must be on a leash on the show grounds. Absolutely no dogs in schooling area or show arenas at any time.

#### **MOTORIZED VEHICLES**

Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the province or state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind, including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles, on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. The parent(s), legal guardians(s), or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are soley responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from that operation. Violations of this rule will be cause for sanctions against the parent(s), guardian(s) and/or trainer(s) who are responsible for the child committing the offense. Penalties may include exclusion of the child, parent(s), guardian(s), and/or trainer(s) from the competition grounds for the remainder of the competition and charges being filed against any of the above individuals in accordance with Chapter 6. Wheelchair and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

**ACCOMMODATION:** Limited camper and trailer parking is available adjacent to the show grounds. **CREDIT CARDS:** Visa and MasterCard accepted.

#### New for 2016: USEF EQUINE VACCINATION RULE

All horses entering the grounds of an Federation-licensed competition must be accompanied by documentation of Equine Influenza Virus and Equine Herpes Virus (Rhinopneumonitis) vaccinations within six months prior to entering the stables. Please refer to GR845 for further details and information on this new ruling. It is the intent of Milner Downs to offer a safe and healthy competition environment for all exhibitors and their horses. #### **USEF MEMBERSHIP STATEMENT**

Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular

Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Preliminary Level or above and Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage, Reining and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides. A nonmember may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, agent, coach or trainer at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions and combined Driving Competitions upon payment of a \$30 nonmember registration fee. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the Requirements of this rule: 1) leadline; 2) exhibitions; 3) games and races; 4) classes for 4-H members; 5) walk trot and academy classes (academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USEF introductory level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes; 7) NRHA Endorsed Reining Competitions. 8) Opportunity classes; 9) citizens of other nations who have proof, in English, of current membership in good standing of their own National Federation; 10) USEA beginner novice division; and 11) assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes.

#### **USEF ENTRY AGREEMENT**

By entering a Federation-licensed Competition and signing this entry blank as the Owner, lessee, Trainer,

Manager, Agent, Coach, Driver, Rider, Handler, Vaulter or Lunger and on behalf of myself and my principles, representatives, employees and agents, I agree that I am subject to the Bylaws and Rules of The United States Equestrian Federation, Inc. (the Federation) and the local rules of Milner Downs 2015

Competitions. I agree to be bound by the bylaws and rules of the Federation and of the competition. I will accept as final the decision of the Hearing Committee on any question arising under the rules, and agree to release and hold harmless the competition, the Federation, their officials, directors and employees for any action taken under the rules. I represent that I am eligible to enter and/or participate under the rules, and every horse I am entering is eligible as entered. I also agree that as a condition of and in consideration of acceptance of entry, the

Federation and/or the Competition may use or assign photographs, videos, audios, cable-casts, broadcasts, internet, film, new media or other likenesses of me and my horse taken during the course of the competition for the promotion, coverage or benefit of the competition, sport, or the Federation. Those likenesses shall not be used to advertise a product and they may not be used in such a way to jeopardize amateur status. I hereby expressly and irrevocably waive and release any right in connection with such use, including any claim to compensation, invasion of privacy, right of publicity, or to misappropriation. The construction and application of Federation rules are governed by the laws of the State of New York, and any action instituted against the Federation are required to be filed in New York State. See GR908.4.

I AGREE in consideration of my participation in this Competition to the following:

I AGREE that the "Federation" and "Competition" as used herein includes the Licensee and Competition

Management, as well as all of their officials, directors, employees, agents, personnel, volunteers and

Federation affiliates.

I AGREE that I choose to participate voluntarily in the Competition with my horse, as a rider, driver, handler, vaulter lunger, lessee, owner, agent, coach, trainer or as a parent or guardian of a junior exhibitor. I am fully aware and acknowledge that horse sports and

the Competition involve inherent dangerous risks or accident, loss, and serious bodily injury including broken bones, head injuries, trauma, pain, suffering or death. (Harm)

I AGREE to expressly assume all risks of Harm to me or my horse, including Harm resulting from the negligence of the Federation of the Competition.

#### 2016 Bio-Security Guidelines

Protecting the health of your horses is of the utmost importance to Milner Downs. In addition to the Required Horse Health Requirements for Vaccination and Event Participation Declaration, Milner has compiled this list of Bio-Security Measures that are excellent guidelines for decreasing the risk of exposure or spread of disease.

#### **DIRECT AND INDIRECT CONTACT BETWEEN HORSES AND PEOPLE:**

The most common path for spreading germs and disease is contact among horses, humans and other animals. Bodily fluids such as nasal discharge, saliva and sweat can carry germs which are easily transmitted from horse to horse through direct and indirect contact.

- ~ Limit horse-to-horse contact
- ~ Limit horse-to-human-to-horse contact
- ~ Limit horse-to-dog(other animal)-to horse, or horse-to-dog-to-human-to-horse contact.
- 1. **Loose dogs will not be tolerated.** Loose dogs in the stabling area, competition area, ship-in area, or found anywhere on the show grounds will be detained. \$50 fine for the first offense, \$100 for the second, and so on. Multiple offenses may result in expulsion from the grounds. *Dogs can be a leading cause of the spread of germs horses nuzzle the dog, people pet the dog then pet the next horse and before you know it, the germs have been spread. Please be courteous and clean up after you dogs on the grounds Milner Downs will have doggie bags and cans available around the grounds.*
- 2. **Restrict unnecessary movement of horses out of their aisle or barn.** Don't take a horse to another barn to be tacked up, braided, clipped, etc. *It may seem easier sometimes, but sharing equipment and grooming supplies, or coming into nose-to-nose contact with other horses or soiled surfaces can spread germs.*
- 3. **Do not lead horses down other tent/barn aisles**. Don't cut through a tent/barn on your way to the paddock or ring; go around the perimeter of the tent/barn. *It may be shorter, but it risks your horse coming into to contact with other horses, soiled surfaces and equipment, dogs, etc.*
- 4. **Don't let horses make nose-to-nose contact** with horses from other barns when in common areas such as wash racks, at the rings, or while grazing. *Yes, it's cute when they want to visit with each other, but germs can spread just like the cold or flu going through a kid's classroom.*
- 5. **Do not touch or pet, or feed treats to horses** from other barns unless necessary. *Yes, we all want to pet all the horses we see, but be mindful that you may be spreading germs from one horse to another when you do this.*

#### **EQUIPMENT HANDLING:**

Soiled equipment is another common path for spreading germs and disease. Nasal discharge, saliva, sweat, and even soiled bedding can carry microbes and spread them via shared items such as tack, equipment, hoses, buckets, grooming supplies and towels.

- 1. **Do not let water hoses touch buckets when filling**. Contact with a contaminated surface on a water bucket can be easily transmitted to the next bucket contacted.
- 2. Do not allow horses to drink from the hose.
- 3. Do not share water or feed buckets.
- 4. Have hand sanitizer readily available, and use it between grooming/tacking up horses. Keep it handy in the grooming stall, on your golf cart, and in your grooming box at the ring
- 5. **Use clean brushes and towels on each horse.** If you don't have enough brushes for each horse to have his own set, be sure to wash them often.
- 6. **Don't share tack and equipment**, especially bits and bridles, unless they are cleaned between each use.

7. **Monitor your horses** & contact Paton & Martin Ass., the Show Veterinarian, at (604) 856-3351 if you notice any unusual symptoms.

Protecting the health of your horses is of the utmost importance to Milner Downs. Milner Downs has implemented

Required Bio-Security Measures to decrease the risk of introduction and/or spread of contagious or infectious disease at its show. The following Health Requirements must be on file in the Horse Show Office for ALL horses entering the Show Grounds, both Showing and Non-showing. Competition numbers will not be issued until the requirements are met.

#### **Health Requirements:**

#### 1. Proof of Vaccination

You must provide proof of vaccination for ALL of your horses on the grounds, showing or not Required Vaccines are: EHV 1 & 4 (Rhino) – within 6 months (180 Days)

# 2. Event Participation Form

You must complete the Event Participation Form, available in the Office, at www.milnerdowns.com or in the prize list.

- **3. Back Numbers will not be issued** until the Health Requirements are met. Milner Downs may require any horse with missing/incomplete/expired Vaccination Records to be placed under observation until the requirements are met.
- **4. Keep copies of your Vaccination records** in your tack room or in your truck/trailer. You may be asked by Milner personnel or to present your health papers at any time.
- **5. Ship-Ins:** If you ship in and out daily, keep copies of your Vaccination records in your truck/trailer. You may be asked to present these records. The Ship-in lot will be checked daily. If proper records are not immediately available, the horse(s) must a.) remain under Milner Staff observation until the paperwork is presented, or b.) will be asked to leave the grounds.
- 6. Ship-ins may ONLY park in the designated areas; Ship-ins MAY NOT park by the barns.

- 1. Be sure to read the Bio-Security tips on the reverse of this page a one-page handout that reviews simple steps we all can take to keep horses healthy!
- 2. Trainers please let your braider know to about the new Bio-Security regulations.

A 1st Year Pre-Green horse has never competed over fences of 3' or higher prior to January 1 of the current year at an EC-sanctioned competition. A 2nd Year Pre-Green horse has never competed over fences higher than 3'3 prior to Jan 1 of the current year at an EC-sanctioned competition. No Pre-Green Hunter may jump 3'6 or higher without jeopardizing their Green status.
